## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 1-84 RELATED TO CONDEMNATION OF STRUCTURES

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and the Town Council of the Village of Elizabeth, Louisiana that the Village does hereby enact this ordinance to read as follows:

## **Section One**

Section Two of Ordinance 1-84 be and is hereby amended to add the following sentence to the end of Section Two, to wit:

"In the alternative, service of notices required under this ordinance may be made by the Clerk or the Clerk's designee by mailing said notice certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, to the last know address of the owner of the structure as indicated upon the tax rolls of the municipality. Service by registered or certified mail shall be deemed effective regardless of whether such mail is actually claimed by the addressee.

## Section Two

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon signing by the Mayor, or in the event of veto, shall become effective upon the day following override of such veto, if any.

Ordinance introduced on the 27th day of June 2022 by Alderman Ken Kelly.
