## ORDINANCE NO. 18-19.2 Village of Elizabeth ELIZABETH, LOUISIANA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF ELIZABETH TO AMEND THE MAYOR'S SALARY BY INCREASE, CONSIDERED FULLTIME AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

**BE IT ORDAINED,** by the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen of the Village of Elizabeth, Louisiana, that the Code of Ordinance, Village of Elizabeth, is hereby enacting Amendment to **Ordinance No. 18-19A1** to become **Ordinance 18-19.2** of the Code of Ordinances, which shall read as follows:

**BE IT ORDAINED**, that Ordinance 18-19.2 is hereby adopted with regard to the salary paid to the Mayor. Said salary shall be increased, from \$1600.00 to \$2600.00, effective March 1, 2023, as follows:

Mayor:

monthly gross of \$2600

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the office of Mayor for the Village of Elizabeth will be considered as full time until further consideration of the Board of Aldermen.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this ordinance shall become effective March 1, 2023, upon signature of the Mayor; or, if not signed or vetoed by the Mayor, upon expiration of the time for ordinances to become law without signature by the Mayor.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the Mayor's salary shall be reduced to \$1600 gross per month at the beginning of the next term of office. (January 1, 2027)

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that if any provision or item of this ordinance of the application thereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions, items, or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions, items, or applications, and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared severable.

**BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED** that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

THIS ORDINANCE 18-19.2 was introduced on the 9th day of January, 2023.

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**Notice of Public Hearing** posted on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2023. **PUBLIC HEARING** prior to Adoption of Ordinance 18-19.2 held on February 13, 2023.

The above and foregoing **Ordinance No. 18-19.2** was read and called for a vote at a meeting of the Board of Aldermen called for said purpose on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2023. Motion was made by Councilwoman Mea Dillehay and seconded by Councilman Ken Kelly to adopt said amendment to Ordinance.
