

To regulate the sale, possession, and discharging of fire works, and to provide penalties for violation of the regulations.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Elizabeth that:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, exchange, barter, or in any manner dispose of, or to have in his possession for such purposes or to shoot or explode, blank pistols, fire crackers, roman candles, sky rockets, spit devils, or any other fire works within the corporate limits of the town at any time, except during the periods of any year from the first of December to the third of January, both dates inclusive, and from the third of July to the fifth of July, both dates inclusive.


Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to shoot or explode any blank pistols, or fire works at any time in a building or automobile, or to throw fire works against the person of another or in, on or against any building or automobile. This section shall be enforced and operation at all times, and shall not be suspended during the periods set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance.


Section 3. The Town Marshal is hereby authorized to seize and confiscate all fire works sold, exchanged, or possessed in violation of the terms and provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars, or imprisoned for a term not exceeding thirty days, or by both fine and imprisonment within the discretion of the court.
